Itinerary

DAY 01: HUARAZ - CHIQUIAN - CUARTELHUAIN (4,180 M.)

- Driving time: 5 hours approx.
- Camping: Quartelhuain,
- Overnight Camp (B/L/D).

DAY 02: CUARTELHUAIN (4,180 M.) - CACANAN PUNTA PASS (4,700 M.) - MITUCOCHA (4,230 M.)

- Hiking time: 5 hours approx.
- Camping: Mitucocha.
- Overnight Camp (B/L/D).

DAY 03: MITUCOCHA (4,230 M.) - CARHUAC PASS "YANAPUNTA" (4,650 M.) - LAGUNA CARHUACOCHA (4,140 M.)

- Hiking time: 6 hours approx.

- Camping: Carhuacocha
- Overnight Camp (B/L/D).

DAY 04: LAGUNA CARHUACOCHA (4,140 M.) - PASO SIULA (4,830 M.) - HUAYHUASH (4,350 M.)

- Hiking time: 8 hours approx.
- Camping: Huayhuash
- Overnight Camp (B/L/D).

DAY 05: HUAYHUASH (4,350 M.) - PASO PORTACHUELO (4,780 M.) - LAGUNA VICONGA (BAÑOS TERMALES GUÑO G 4350M.)

- Hiking time: 5 hours approx.
- Camping: Baños termales Guñog
- Overnight Camp (B/L/D).

DAY 06: BAÑOS TERMALES GUÑO G - CUYOC PASS (5,050 M.) - CUYOCPAMPA (4,560 M.) - SAN ANTONIO VIEWPOINT (5,079 M.)

- Optional: Climbing Mt. pumarinri 5.465 m. (*)
- Hiking time: 7 hours approx.
- Camping: Cuyocpampa
- Overnight Camp (B/L/D).

DAY 07: CUYOCPAMPA (4,560 M.) - SANTA ROSA PASS (5,070 M.) - HUAYLLAPA (3,600 M.)

- Hiking time: 9 hours approx.
- Camping: Huayllapa village
- Overnight Camp (B/L/D).

DAY 08: HUAYLLAPA (3,600 M.) - TAPUSH PASS (4,770 M.) - GASHPAPAMPA (4,570 M.)

- Hiking time: 7 hours approx.
- Camping: Gashpapampa
- Overnight Camp (B/L/D).

DAY 09: GASHPAPAMPA (4,570 M.) - PUNTA LLAUCHA PASS (4,850 M.) - LAGUNA JAHUACOCHA (4,100M.)

- Optional: Climbing Mt. diablo mudo 5.427 m. (*)
- Hiking time: 6 hours approx.
- Camping: Jahuacocha
- Overnight Camp (B/L/D).

DAY 10: LAGUNA JAHUACOCHA - PAMPA LLAMAC PASS (4,300 M.) - LLAMAC - HUARAZ

- Hiking time: 5 hours approx.
- Driving time: 5 hours approx. (B/L/-).

* *Climbing Pumarinri or Diablo mudo: Extra charge USD \$100 per person*

What's Included

Included

- Transport: From your hotel in Huaraz to the starting point of the trek, and from the end of the trek

to your hotel in Huaraz.

- Camping: Good quality mountain tents (2 people per tent), mattresses, dining tent, kitchen tent, tables, chairs, dishes and kitchen utensils.
- Meals: Breakfast, lunch and dinner (option for vegetarians or vegans).
- Guide: Certified trekking guide (English or Spanish) for another language by request.
- Cook: Trained cook to prepare varied and healthy dishes.
- Donkey driver: In charge of loading the donkeys and driving them.
- Donkeys: You can carry up 6kg of personal items that will be loaded onto the donkeys. During the day you will only carry your backpack with things for personal use.
- First aid kit.

Not included

- Entrance fee USD 65 (Huayhuash Communities)
- Personal trekking and climbing equipment: Sleeping bag (it is possible to rent in Huaraz), grampons, trekking/climbing shoes or boots, jacket and/or waterproof pants, poncho, backpack, flashlight, etc.
- Additional costs: as a result of leaving the trek early, emergency rescue and/or evacuation, extra food or drinks in towns, medical treatment.
